




Dakhóta sentence structure and the literal translation in English:

Dakhóta: (Object) kin̥ dé (color).

English: (Object) this is (color).

Dakhóta: (Objects) kin̥ dená (color)\*.

English: (Objects) these are (color).

\*The Dakhóta word k'a means "and" in English and is used when including two objects or colors in a sentence.


